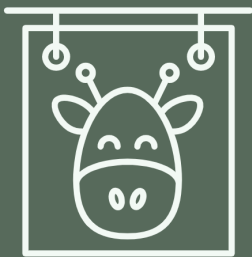


LAKE PLACID IS ONE OF THE FEW PLACES WHERE YOU CAN EXPERIENCE THE THRILL OF RIDING A BOBSLED OR WATCHING THE ATHLETES **JUMP OF THE SKI JUMPS** IN THE WINTER AND THE SUMMER!

Lake Placid hosted the 1932 & 1980 Olympic Winter Games. Along with St. Moritz, Switzerland and Innsbruck, Austria, it is one of only three places in the world to have hosted the Winter Games twice!



NONE OF THE TRI-LAKES VILLAGES (LAKE PLACID, SARANAC LAKE, & TUPPER LAKE) **LIE ON THEIR NAMESAKES!** LAKE PLACID IS LOCATED ON MIRROR LAKE. MIRROR LAKE IS 2.7 MILES AROUND AND APPROXIMATELY 60 FEET DEEP.



SANTA'S WORKSHOP (IN NEARBY WILMINGTON) AT THE NORTH POLE HAS BEEN IN OPERATION SINCE JULY OF 1949. IT WAS ONE OF THE FIRST THEME PARKS IN THE US AND FEATURED **THE WORLD'S FIRST PETTING ZOO!**

Since 1999, Lake Placid has been a site for the Ironman Triathlon - one of only six official Ironmans to be held in the continental US. The Ironman consists of a 2.4-mile swim, a 112-mile bike ride, and a 26.2-mile run.
